

Deir ez-Zor Province - Revolution Dossier

Summary: Eastern conflict theater shaped by ISIS control and anti-ISIS campaigns.

Where: Deir ez-Zor city, Euphrates valley towns, and oil-linked rural zones.

What happened: Siege episodes, ISIS governance periods, coalition operations, and infrastructure collapse.

Why it mattered: The province links energy resources, cross-border routes, and strategic river corridors.

Detention / Saydnaya: Detention/abduction patterns involved multiple actors during changing control phases.

Chemical dossier: No primary high-profile chemical dossier here in the core international legal files.
