

## As-Suwayda Province - Revolution Dossier

**Summary:** Southern province with later civic protests tied to livelihoods and governance demands.

**Where:** As-Suwayda city and surrounding highland communities.

**What happened:** Relative front-distance did not prevent deep economic crisis, local security incidents, and protest waves.

**Why it mattered:** Shows that conflict legacy continued through governance/economy pressure, not only frontline warfare.

**Detention / Saydnaya:** Arrest and security concerns appear in local protest periods and broader conflict-era patterns.

**Chemical dossier:** No primary chemical dossier in Suwayda in core international reporting tracks.
